Special Olympics Law Enforcement Torch Run to be Held in La Vista

The City of La Vista will host Special Olympics Nebraska and its annual Law Enforcement Torch Run on Tuesday, May 18, beginning at 10:45 a.m.

The run kicks off festivities for the Nebraska Summer Games to be held May 19-22 in Omaha, and will begin near the northwest corner of 72nd Street and Giles Road.
