## **La Vista Swimming Pool to Open Saturday, May 29**

The La Vista Swimming Pool, 7529 S. 85<sup>th</sup> Street, will open for the summer on Saturday, May 29 at 3 p.m. following the conclusion of the La Vista Daze parade.

In operation since the early 1960s, the La Vista Swimming Pool features two water slides, a toddler wading area, bathhouse, concession stand and shade structures.

The La Vista Swimming Pool will host a 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary commemorative event this summer, the Splash Bash. Pool admission will be free on Sunday, August 1, from 1 to 3 p.m. Also, free food will be available, while supplies last, and families can enjoy a variety of lawn and pool games together.

Pool staff will also offer three sessions of swimming lessons this summer for \$25 for residents and \$50 for non-residents. The first session will run June 14-25, the second session will run July 12-23 and the third session will begin July 26 and end August 6. Start times vary from 9 a.m. to noon, depending on experience level. Children four and older are welcome to register and lessons are held Monday-Thursday each session. Registrations must be completed at the La Vista Community Center, 8116 Park View Boulevard.

Pool hours this year will be 1 p.m.-9 p.m. daily and admission rates vary from \$2 for resident youths 6-17 years of age up to \$4 for non-resident adults. Children ages 5 and under are free.

Season passes for youths, adults, families and day care centers are available by calling the La Vista Community Center, 331-3455.
