Police Department Receives Grant for Drug Collection Unit

The La Vista Police Department has received a grant from CVS Pharmacy and The Partnership for Drug-Free Kids for a drug collection unit intended to reduce the amount of unneeded medicine in residents' homes and decrease prescription drug abuse.

The unit will be located in the lobby of the Police Station, 7701 S. 96th Street, and will be open to the public 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday.

The drug collection unit will provide residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of unwanted, unused or expired medication, including controlled substances, no questions asked.

“Safely disposing of unused medication is critical to protecting our children and our environment,” said La Vista Police Chief Bob Lausten. “La Vista is proud to partner with CVS Pharmacy and we thank them for their commitment to help residents reduce the amount of unneeded medicine in our community.”
