Sarpy County Multi-Agency DUI Task Force Halloween Impaired Driving Enforcement

The Sarpy County Multi-Agency DUI Task Force, a partnership between the La Vista, Papillion and Bellevue police departments and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office, will have officers working over the Halloween weekend, focused on the detection and apprehension of impaired drivers. Officers will be using high visibility patrols throughout Sarpy County on Friday, October 30, and Saturday, October 31.

With Halloween falling over a weekend this year, the goal of the Task Force operation will be to encourage those who consume alcohol to designate a driver or make other arrangements to get home safely, ultimately providing a safe weekend for the additional pedestrian traffic as trick or treating children and parents enjoy the weekend.
