ORDINANCE NO. 959

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA VISTA, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO AMEND THE LA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 30.42; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES PREVIOUSLY ENACTED; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VISTA, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Section 30.42. Section 30.42 of the La Vista Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

§ 30.42 PROCEDURE FOR RESOLUTIONS AND MOTIONS.

(A) Resolutions shall be introduced in one of the methods prescribed for the introduction of ordinances; provided, however, resolutions shall not be required to be read by title on three different days. After their introduction, written resolutions having a title shall be fully and distinctly read by title in the presence and hearing of a majority of the members elected to the City Council. Any written resolution not having a title shall, after its introduction, be fully and distinctly read in its entirety upon the request of any member of the City Council who is present at the meeting.

(B) Motions shall be made, and the issue raised by any resolution or motion shall be disposed of, in accordance with the usage of parliamentary law set forth in Municipal Code Section 33.24 or as otherwise adopted for the guidance of the City Council. Unless otherwise provided by applicable law, a majority vote shall be required to pass any resolution or motion. The vote on any resolution or motion shall be by roll call vote or by use of an electronic voting device that allows the yeas and nays of each member of the City Council to be readily seen by the public.

SECTION 2. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances and parts of ordinances as previously enacted that are in conflict with this Ordinance or any part hereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Mayor and City Council of the City of La Vista hereby declare that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
